This employee is not a member of the customer-facing wait staff, but was present in the restaurant between the hours of 2pm and 9pm on Tuesday, January 5 and 2pm and 5pm on Wednesday, January 6.

Out of an abundance of caution and a steadfast commitment to doing what is in the best interest of our employees and our loyal guests, we have made the decision to close Forno Bistro from January 7 until January 11 with the fullest intention to re-open on January 12.

We are committed to ensuring a safe dining experience and have been following all CDC recommended distancing, capacity, and cleanliness guidelines. We will continue to follow these protocols and will be performing a deep clean and sanitization of the entire restaurant before we re-open. Moreover, to ensure the safety and health of our staff, all employees that worked on Tuesday and/or Wednesday of this week will receive a test for coronavirus.

The safety of our employees, their loved ones and our guests has been and will always be our top priority as we work tirelessly to keep our restaurants safe. If you were in Forno Bistro on Tuesday, January 5 and/or Wednesday, January 6 we are recommending that you closely monitor yourself for Covid-19 symptoms for the next 14 days and to get tested for Coronavirus.
